(1) Regular Overseas Training Programs

The program is carried out in developing country/region only for trainees who are residents of that country/region.

(2) Third Country Training Programs

The program is carried out in both developed and developing country/region for trainees who are residents of that country/region and non residents invited from neighboring developing countries/regions.

2) Training Activities for Industrial Structure Improvement (FY2000-)

AOTS organizes training programs on Industrial Property Rights, environmental problems, etc., to cooperate in reforming industrial structure and economic systems.

(1) Regular Overseas Training Programs

These programs are carried out in a developing country/region for trainees who are residents of that country/region.

(2) Third Country Training Programs

The program is carried out in both developed and developing countries/regions for trainees who are residents of those countries/regions and non residents invited from neighboring developing countries/regions.

3) Lecturing Tours:

Upon request from AOTS Alumni Societies, AOTS sends Japanese experts to local seminars organized by the AOTS Alumni Societies.
